The GRUB Program (Growing Recruits for Urban Business) provides area youth with life skills and job skills through the management of the 5-acre Carolyn Lanier Youth Farm.

Share of the Harvest

The price of a share is the total cost incurred in producing the harvest divided by the estimated number of shares. In order to streamline the garden operations and purchases of seed, supplies, and equipment, shareholders will pay the full amount at the beginning of the farming season.

When fully developed, the GRUB Farm Youth Garden can accommodate approximately 100 shares. Shares for the 2020 crop will be limited. Sign-up will be on a first come, first served basis. **Space for current year shareholders will be reserved until March 1, 2020.** The essential ingredient in all of this is commitment. The GRUB youth are committing to the work; in return, your commitment provides the capital at the time it is needed to grow your food.

Please keep in mind that this is a farming venture and with any farming venture certain risks are present. The main risk is weather. As a shareholder in our farm you take on the same risk as the farmer. We do not offer a refund if produce is not as bountiful as anticipated.

Pick up on Thursdays from 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Fridays 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Pickup at 304 76th – corner of 76th and Ave B.

Season is approximately June through October.

Shareholders are notified by email when produce distribution begins.
