The South Plains Food Bank's 38th Annual U Can Share Holiday Fund Drive is a community-wide effort to feed those in need across the South Plains.

History: U Can Share began as a service of Skip Watson & KCBD News Channel 11 in November of 1982.

Goal: 750,000 meals (or \$250,000 cash)

Mission: 1 in 7 people across the South Plains are food insecure. 1 in 4 are children. The food and funds collected during the drive help us serve the hungry well into the new year for families in need.

Sponsors of the Day: These are area businesses and organizations who make a financial contribution to sponsor a day of the fund drive. These partners are featured on KCBD and share their total food/monetary donations collected for the drive.

TV Coverage Sponsor, Prosperity Bank: Prosperity Bank has partnered with the SPFB to help cover the cost of TV coverage. Live and continuous coverage are given multiple times throughout the day.

Serving: Over 180 agencies & churches help provide 18,000 meals a week and food to over 57,000 unduplicated people each year.

Supporting: The SPFB services 20 counties with a population of over 500,000 people. 2020 has seen need in the South Plains increase to over 150,000 people.
